**October 31, 2017-November 14, 2017**

Bring non-perishable foods indicated EACH day to participate in the following events:

**Tuesday, October 31: Monster Mash.** Students must bring at least one can or box of potatoes to receive a Halloween themed jeans day. Wear your orange or Halloween attire. No masks, costumes, or inappropriate shirts (blood, etc.) are allowed. Students choosing to get school pictures retaken will be permitted to change into Halloween attire after their picture if they choose to do so.

**Monday, November 6: Favorite sports team day.** Students who bring at least one can of their choice may dress in their favorite sports team shirt or jersey. Jeans and sweatpants are permitted. Pajama pants, tight fitting pants/jeans, pants with holes, rips, tatters, or yoga pants are not permitted.

**Tuesday, November 7: Extra Recess Day.** Students who bring at least one can of their choice will receive extra recess at the end of the day. Regular school dress code must be worn this day.

**Wednesday, November 8: Wacky Wednesday.** Students may dress "wacky" or mismatched on this day. Wear clothing that makes us laugh. Jeans and sweatpants are permitted. Hats are also permitted. Pajama pants, tight fitting pants/jeans, pants with holes, rips, tatters, or yoga pants are not permitted. Shirts must have sleeves. No inappropriate phrases on clothing.

**Thursday, November 9: Movie day.** Students who bring at least 5 cans will be able to use those cans to buy a movie ticket. Many classrooms will be showing afternoon movies and the students will be able to choose which movie they would like to see. Regular school dress code must be worn this day.

**Friday, November 10: Red, white, and blue day.** Students who bring at least one can of their choice may wear red, white, and blue in honor of Veterans Day. Jeans and tennis shoes are permitted. Pajama pants, tight fitting pants/jeans, pants with holes, rips, tatters, or yoga pants are not permitted. All clothing items must be school-appropriate.

**Monday, November 13: Three can jeans day.** Students must bring **3 cans** for our final canned food jeans day. One can for jeans, one can for a shirt, and one can for tennis shoes. Pajama pants, tight fitting pants/jeans, pants with holes, rips, tatters, or yoga pants are not permitted. All clothing items must be school-appropriate.

**Tuesday, November 14: Canned food drive raffle.** For every canned food students bring, they will receive a raffle ticket to win a prize.

**Please note:**

The canned food drive will take place between October 31 and November 14. All items will benefit the St. Augustine Parish St. Vincent De Paul Society. If there is no specified event on a day, students are still encouraged to bring cans, but must be in school uniform. On days where events are scheduled, students who do not bring cans will be sent to an age-appropriate study hall.
