Classroom News

Our students still have plenty of learning to do before the end of our school year!

Our kindergarten students will be assessed on money (pennies, nickels, and dimes) before they move into telling time to the hour. They are also working on reading short o words.

The first grade will be learning about telling time next week. In English, they are identifying antonyms. They are also learning about the Native Americans.

In second grade, one math group is identifying and using the standard measurements of inches, feet, and yards, while another math group is learning about area and perimeter. In social studies, they are learning about trading with other colonies, while they are identifying physical changes in science.

Our fourth graders are learning about Ohio's changing economy in social studies. One math group is working with fractions.

The fifth graders are learning about Central America in social studies. In religion, they are studying the sacrament of marriage.

In sixth grade, students are practicing Spanish verb tenses. One math group is learning about theoretical probability in math class.

Our seventh graders just finished reading Katherine Paterson's Bridge to Terabithia and have taken their end of the novel assessment.

The eighth graders are studying the Spanish verbs 'ser' and 'estar.'

Students in Miss Mazzagatti's fourth grade spelling group and all of the fifth through eighth graders are starting their last unit in spelling. Page 232 is due on Thursday, May 24; the unit test will be Friday, May 25. Mrs. Faessel's spelling group is finished with spelling for this year.
