Utility bills must show service and billing addresses. Copies of bills before you pay them are best for showing both service and billing addresses.

If your child currently has an EdChoice expansion scholarship or you believe your child may qualify for this scholarship, please come to one of the above meetings with four pay stubs or other income verification materials so that you can also complete the required income verification form.
